



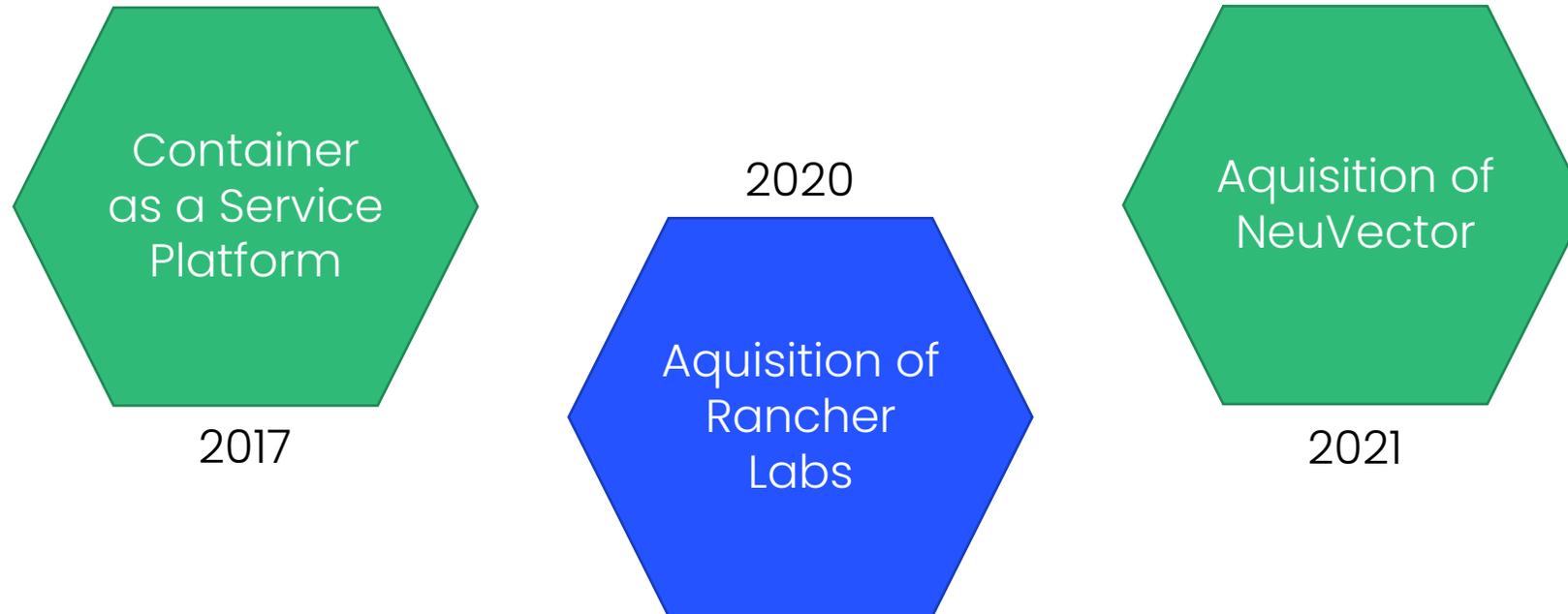

Observation of Open Source as Big Driving Force

- For cloud-native environments
- Built cloud-natively

Why?

- Validation
(of idea, implementation, small engineering project,...)
- Contributors
- Users
- Nurturing of Sales Pipeline
- Messaging (PR, Marketing,...)
- Company Policy
(yes, but...)

Not so Minor Details

— License

- Copyleft or less binding?
- Often “decided” by context

Apache 2

— Patents

Open Invention Network (OIN)

— Trademarks

Keep (NeuVector) + New (OZT)

— Code Availability

GitHub

- GitHub, ftp.example.com, Image Registries, ...

— “Housing”

Donation to CNCF

- Self, new project/umbrella, existing project/umbrella, combination



It's All About Timing

- Announce Intent: as early as possible
- Deliver whatever you can quickly
 - Comb through sources: customer info, licensing, terminology, 3rd party,...
- Show plan/roadmap
- Deliver on plan
 - Complete open sourcing
 - Add some spice
- Depending on The Why
 - Invite users
 - Invite contributors
 - Present at conferences and other events
 - Press, social media,...



Keep The Engine Running

- Upstream \longleftrightarrow Downstream/Product relationship
- Flow of bug reports, patches
- Release Management
- “Product Management”
- Handling Contributions
- Accessible Infrastructure
- Other Policies
